FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

• If you are currently receiving assistance through Ontario Works (OW) or Ontario Disability Support Programs (ODSP) you can contact your caseworker and inform them of your situation. Your caseworker can help answer some of your concerns if you need assistance with relocation costs such as first and last months rent.

• Emergency financial assistance may

be available through the Ontario Works program. If you have questions concerning potential eligibility for Ontario Works (OW) call this number 722-3132 and press 3 to access the Ontario Works Department and then press 5 to access the emergency caseworker unit. Your call will be answered by a staff member who will complete an assessment over the phone with you. The staff member will

inform you if you are eligible and qualify for financial assistance. Staff can also provide you with community resource information.
